




Beach Monitoring









E. coli Monitoring

- EPA BEACH Act Funding
- Lake Superior beaches and tributaries are routinely monitored to assess if water quality is safe for swimming.
- Swim advisories are posted if E. coli levels are elevated.



E. coli Monitoring

• Total annual exceedances at Lake Superior beaches within the Bad River Reservation ranged from 3 to 9 during 2013-2017. In 2018, the total number of exceedances was 15 (or 18% of the samples collected).

• In 2004, the Tribal Council approved and declared Lake Superior Day celebration (resolution no. 7-14-04-303).






