



Fund for Lake Michigan

- The Fund was established in 2008 as part of a settlement over the Oak Creek Power Plant.
- The settlement calls for payments of \$4 million per year for 25 years to support projects that address, reduce and mitigate water quality impacts.



• To date, FFLM has awarded 400 grants totaling \$24.6 million.
