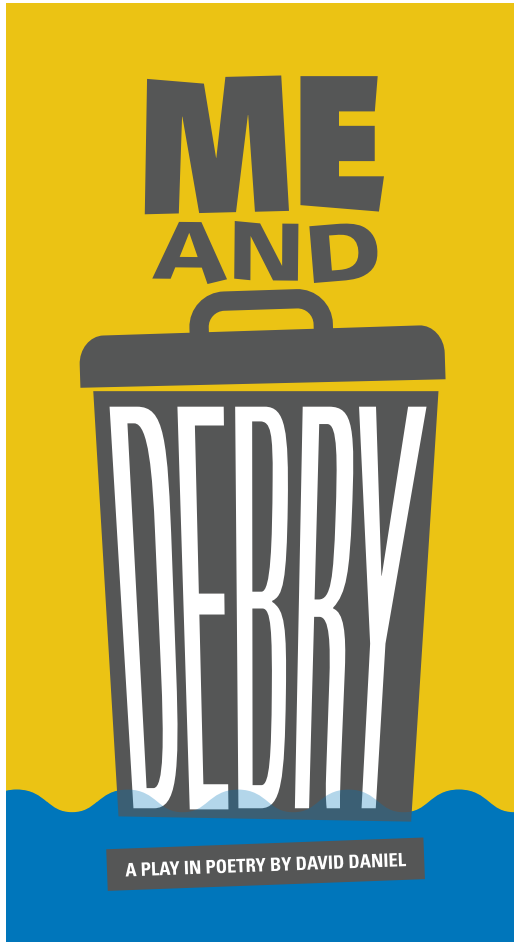

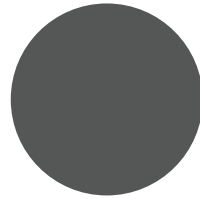
## LOGO

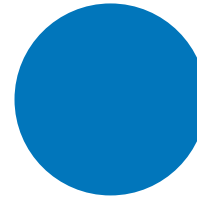

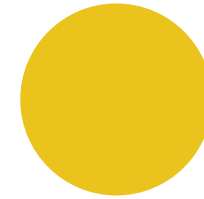
